We will be administering the PSAT exams at no cost to all of our 10<sup>th</sup> grade students on Wednesday, October 16<sup>th</sup>. Taking the PSAT exam in 10<sup>th</sup> grade and 11<sup>th</sup> grade will assist in students scoring higher on the SAT exams later in high school. Please encourage your child to put forth their best effort in these exams so that they can be as prepared as possible for the SAT exams and also for various scholarship opportunities based on their PSAT 11<sup>th</sup> grade results. All 10<sup>th</sup> grade TCHS or DCCC student will remain on campus during this date to take the PSAT exam.

Our 9<sup>th</sup> grade students will be involved in numerous College and Career Readiness and educational activities this same date that will help them develop their portfolio for post-secondary opportunities as well as educate them on important topics. Our Youth Mentoring Partnership Coaches will be working with our Health teachers next Wednesday and Thursday in all Health classes to educate our 9<sup>th</sup> grade student on how to develop goals. 9<sup>th</sup> grade students will then participate in a goal setting exercise led by the YMP coaches during PSAT testing. These goals will then be submitted to advisory teachers where the YMP coaches in conjunction with advisory teachers will monitor student progress towards these goals throughout the year. In addition to goal setting, we have also arranged for a vaping education segment, a mental health education segment, a Safe To Say refresher training, and college and career readiness surveys.

The CASD Technology Taskforce met this past Wednesday specifically to discuss the 1:1 Initiative and details surrounding the distribution of devices and the collection of the Technology Insurance Fee (TIF). The district wants to make sure that we are prepared and roll out these devices responsibly. We also want to make sure the Chromebooks have the proper components to use not only in school, but also at home. With these items in mind, the district and the taskforce have opted to postpone the distribution of the Chromebooks until Wednesday, November 6.
