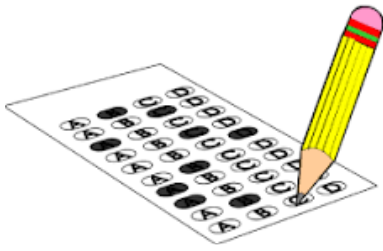

Message from the Principal, Dr. Lennon



Hello Caln Families!

The Caln staff and students were thrilled to have Eagles player, Zech McPhearson, #27 CB, as a special guest on Friday, April 26th. We appreciate the opportunity provided by Mr. Justin Brown, a wonderful parent liaison who serves as the Director of Diversity,

Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) at Downingtown Area School District. Through the superb facilitation of Mr. Brown, our students were able to interactively learn about Zech's history and how he persevered through school to become a successful player of our beloved Philadelphia Eagles team. This experience inspired us all and our students in grades 3-5 our feeling invigorated to take on next week's PSSA testing! Please enjoy the pictures below.

We are moving into week #2, the final week, of PSSA testing. Our students in grades 3-5 will test in Math and students in grade 4 only, will test in Science. Please read my letter below for the complete testing schedule.

It is an expectation that all students in all grades (K-5) will arrive to school on time since the main hallway needs to remain especially quiet and without unnecessary interruptions. Our 4th grade students are housed in the main hallway and small group testing will occur in this hallway, too. Therefore, it is very important for everyone to arrive on time. **Student arrival begins at 9:15 AM and students are considered tardy after 9:30 AM. Testing will begin promptly at 9:45** which leaves ample time for students to enjoy a healthy school breakfast. Please plan ahead of time, be sure your child receives a good night of rest, and ensure that your child arrives on time especially during these two weeks of testing.

It is also very important for all students to keep any and all technology (phones, smartwatches, etc.) at home during the two weeks of testing. The state has strict policies in place that we must follow if a student brings any form of technology to school (read the **Electronic Device letter** below).

The *PSSA Student Code of Conduct* is also found below. It will be reviewed by me with all students during our PEP RALLY and again with your child's teacher prior to testing. I also ask that the parents and guardians of all students in grades 3-5 review these important policies with their child prior to Tuesday.

If you have not had a chance to read the PSSA communications below (I provided them for 3 weeks), then please take the time to thoroughly and carefully read and review **all communications with your 3rd - 5th grader prior to Tuesday.**

PLEASE REMEMBER:

- School doors open for students at 9:15 AM. Your child is considered **tardy after 9:30 AM** - *Dr. Lennon is closely monitoring student attendance.*
 - *If you or a family member is dropping off a student at the front of the building, which means you missed parent drop off to the east side of our building and it is after 9:30, then you must park in a parking spot and bring your child(ren) into the main entrance to sign them in. It is the parent's or guardian's responsibility to make sure that students arrive to school on time. In addition, for the safety of your child(ren), walking them into school is the safest policy. Furthermore, since our students are in elementary school, it is best for the parent or guardian to state the reason for the lateness.*
 - School instructional times are 9:15 am - 3:45 pm.
 - **Main Office Hours:** The main office hours are 8:30 am - 4:30 pm. Staff hours are 8:45-4:15 pm.
 - **Early Dismissal:** A note/email should be sent in the morning to CNAttendance@casdschools.org. The note for early dismissals should contain: Student Name/Teacher/Date and Time of Dismissal/Reason/Name of Adult picking up and relationship/Parent Signature and parent daytime phone#. **It is very important to get these notes into your child's teacher or to the main office prior to 2:00 pm.**
All early dismissals should be completed at the main office by 3:15. Students must be signed out. Dismissals after 3:15 will be in the parent pick-up line.
The adult picking up must bring a government issued Photo ID (preferably a driver's license).
 - **Parent-Pick-Up Line Reminder:** If you are picking up your child from school, please do your best to keep your vehicle to the far right when pulling out of our parking lot so that traffic does not block or slow down the emergency vehicles at the neighboring firehouse.
 - **Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports (PBIS):** We practice 3 important expectations at Caln: **RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY & SAFETY.** I ask that all adults be role models for our children/our students. This is a team effort.

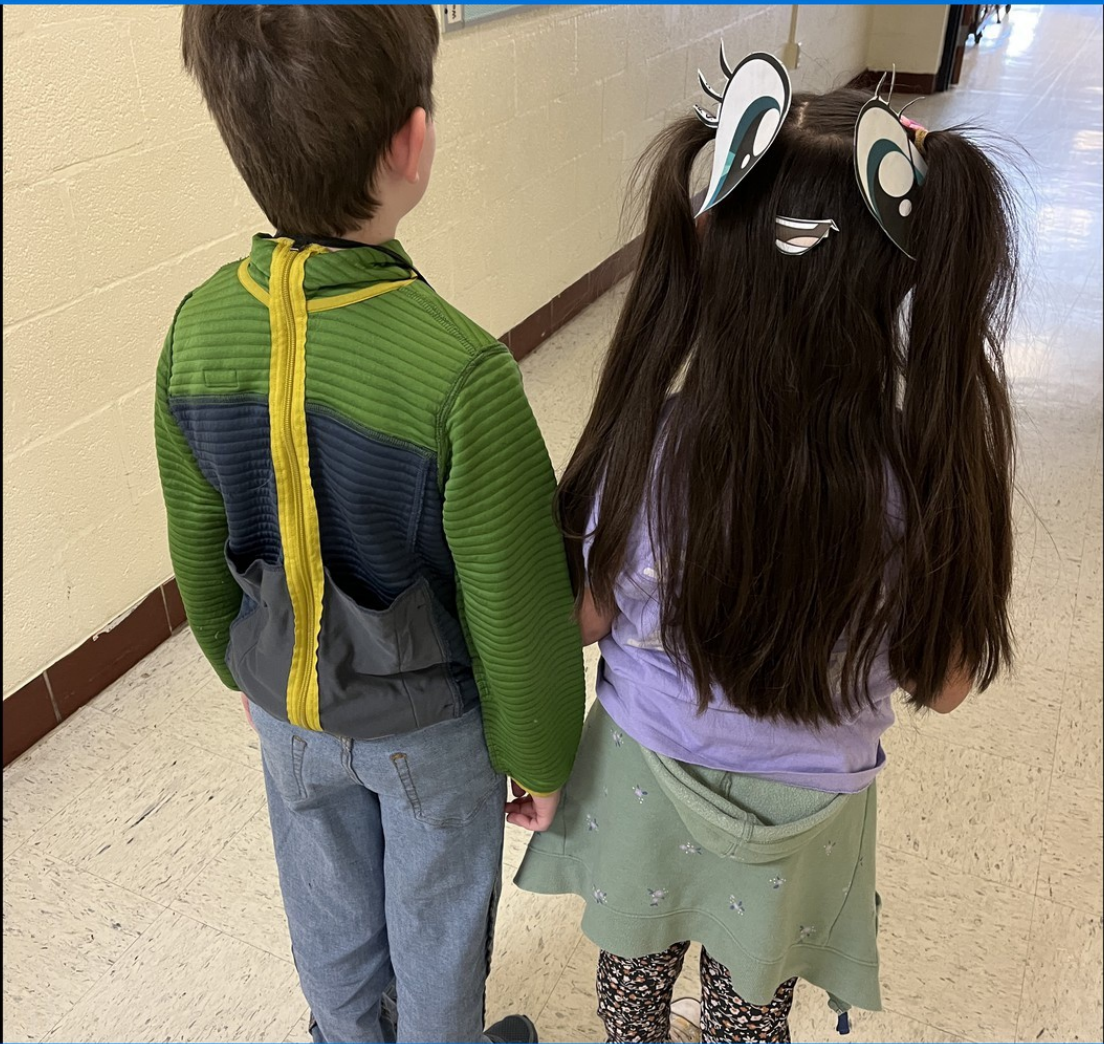

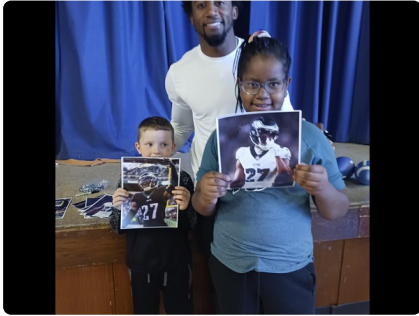

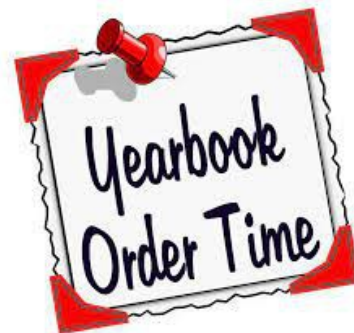
CALN PTA NEWS

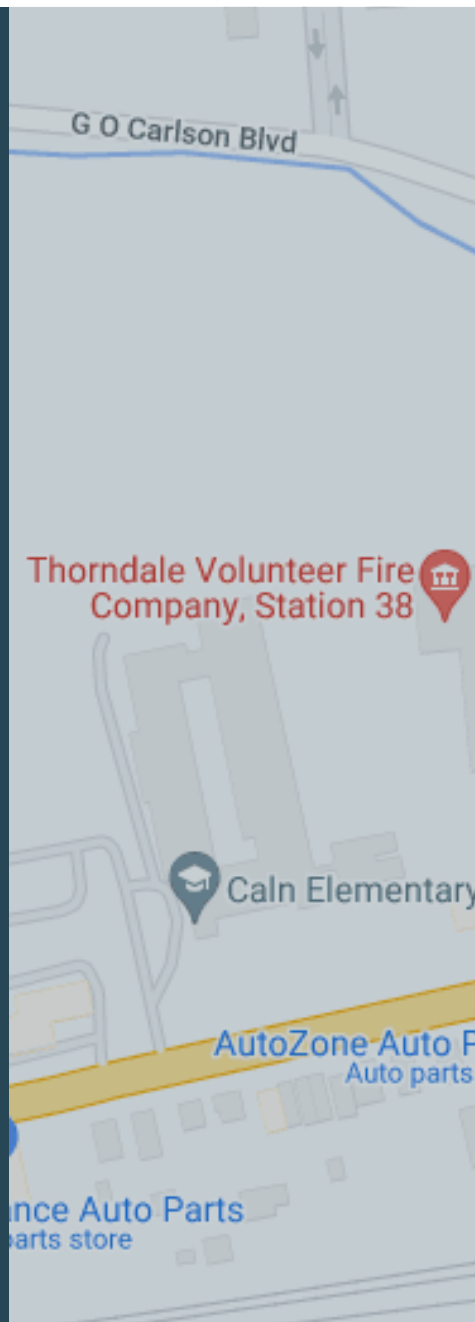
