SPECIAL MESSAGE REGARDING PARENT PICK-UP: 🚗 🚗 🚗

Please do not move past the cones, or remove the cones, to enter the back asphalt/playground area. ***This is a safety concern.*** This area is used as a playground for our primary students and our teachers may have the students outside for recess on the blacktop area until 3:15 pm. Therefore, parents who pick up should wait to enter our pick-up area after 3:15 pm. Our pick-up line runs extra smooth this year and therefore we ask that you wait until after 3:15 to get in line. We truly appreciate your immediate cooperation with this matter.

I am looking forward to seeing our parents and families of our students who will be participating in the Spring Concert this Thursday evening from 7 - 8 pm. As always, please contact the school regarding any questions you may have.

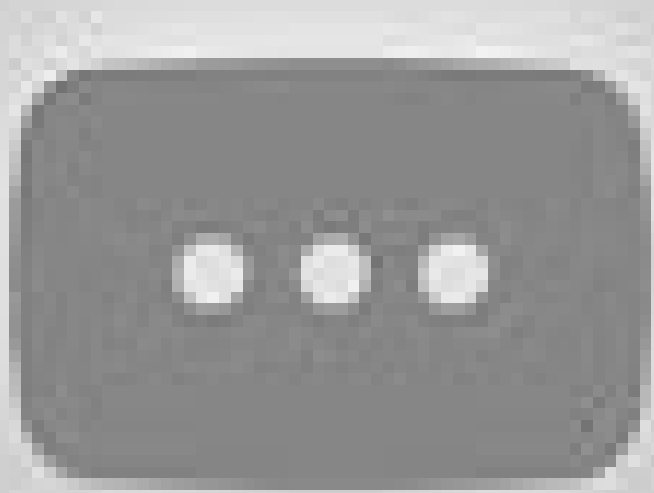
PLEASE REMEMBER:

- School doors open for students at 9:15 AM. Your child is considered **tardy after 9:30 AM** - ***Dr. Lennon is closely monitoring student attendance.***

- *If you or a family member is dropping off a student at the front of the building, which means you missed parent drop off to the east side of our building and it is after 9:30, then you must park in a parking spot and bring your child(ren) into the main entrance to sign them in. It is the parent's or guardian's responsibility to make sure that students arrive to school on time. In addition, for the safety of your child(ren), walking them into school is the safest policy. Furthermore, since our students are in elementary school, it is best for the parent or guardian to state the reason for the lateness.*
 - School instructional times are 9:15 am - 3:45 pm.
 - **Main Office Hours:** The main office hours are 8:30 am - 4:30 pm. Staff hours are 8:45-4:15 pm.
 - **Early Dismissal:** A note/email should be sent in the morning to CNAAttendance@casdschools.org. The note for early dismissals should contain: Student Name/Teacher/Date and Time of Dismissal/Reason/Name of Adult picking up and relationship/Parent Signature and parent daytime phone#. **It is very important to get these notes into your child's teacher or to the main office prior to 2:00 pm.**
All early dismissals should be completed at the main office by 3:15. Students must be signed out. **Dismissals after 3:15 will be in the parent pick-up line.**
The adult picking up must bring a government issued Photo ID (preferably a driver's license).
 - **Parent-Pick-Up Line Reminder:** If you are picking up your child from school, please do your best to keep your vehicle to the far right when pulling out of our parking lot so that traffic does not block or slow down the emergency vehicles at the neighboring firehouse.
 - **Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports (PBIS):** We practice 3 important expectations at Caln: **RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY & SAFETY.** I ask that all adults be role models for our children/our students. This is a team effort.

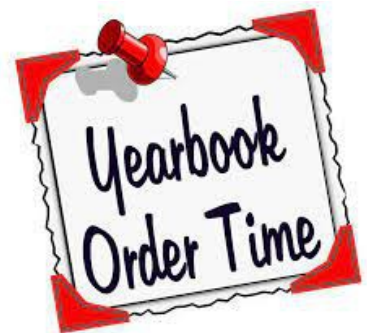

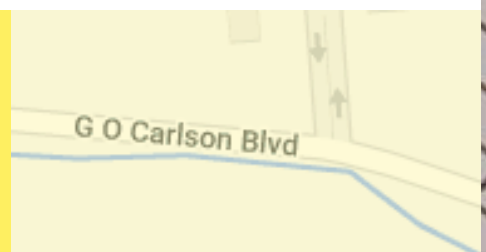

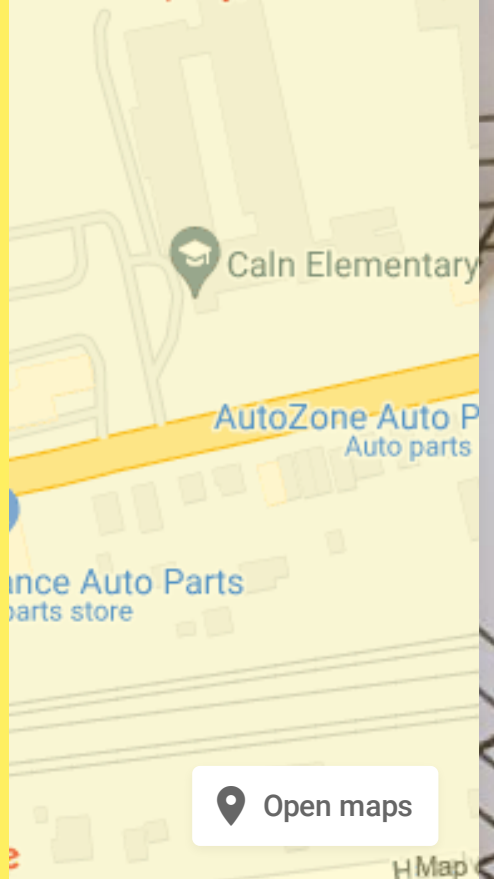
