# Message from the Principal, Dr. Lennon



*Hello Caln Families!*

Huge **SHOUT OUT** to the Caln music department and all of the fourth and fifth grade musicians and chorus participants. The Spring Concert surely did not disappoint and was one of the BEST yet! Thank you to everyone who attended - families, friends, staff, and Dr. Rybarczyk our Assistant Superintendent.

Well, it looks like we have only *four* more weeks of school, and this coming week being our last full five days. This Wednesday will be a half day for our students and we have a planned FIELD DAY event with the event schedule starting at 9:30 AM. We dismiss promptly at 12:30 PM. Please be sure to pick up your child no later than 12:45 because all staff, including myself, must travel to other school sites for inservice.

Speaking of field day, please be sure to have your child(ren) dress appropriately and in the correct t-shirt color. Each classroom has been assigned a classroom color. ***Please reach out directly to your child's teacher via email or Class DoJo if you are unsure of the assigned color.*** Also, make sure that your child wears protective sun gear/sunblock and brings along enough water to keep hydrated.

While the end of the school year is near, we have not stopped learning along with having a splash of fun, and we will still be providing as much structure and routine as possible. We ask that you please review the Caln expectations of Respect, Responsibility, and Safety with your child(ren), especially if they ride on a bus or if you have heard from me or your child's teacher recently regarding discipline concerns.

## **SPECIAL MESSAGE REGARDING PARENT PICK-UP:** 🚗 🚗 🚗

Please do not move past the cones, or remove the cones, to enter the back asphalt/playground area. ***This is a safety concern.*** This area is used as a playground for our primary students and our teachers may have the students outside for recess on the blacktop area until 3:15 pm. Therefore, parents who pick up should wait to enter our pick-up area after 3:15 pm. Our pick-up line runs extra smooth this year and therefore we ask that you wait until after 3:15 to get in line. We truly appreciate your immediate cooperation with this matter.

## **PLEASE REMEMBER:**

- School doors open for students at 9:15 AM. Your child is considered **tardy after 9:30 AM** - ***Dr. Lennon is closely monitoring student attendance.***
- ***If you or a family member is dropping off a student at the front of the building, which means you missed parent drop off to the east side of our building and it is after 9:30, then you must park in a parking spot and bring your child(ren) into the main entrance to sign them in. It is the parent's or guardian's responsibility to make sure that students arrive to school on time. In***

*addition, for the safety of your child(ren), walking them into school is the safest policy. Furthermore, since our students are in elementary school, it is best for the parent or guardian to state the reason for the lateness.*

- School instructional times are 9:15 am - 3:45 pm.
  - **Main Office Hours:** The main office hours are 8:30 am - 4:30 pm. Staff hours are 8:45-4:15 pm.
  - **Early Dismissal:** A note/email should be sent in the morning to [CNAAttendance@casdschools.org](mailto:CNAAttendance@casdschools.org). The note for early dismissals should contain: Student Name/Teacher/Date and Time of Dismissal/Reason/Name of Adult picking up and relationship/Parent Signature and parent daytime phone#. **It is very important to get these notes into your child's teacher or to the main office prior to 2:00 pm.**  
**All early dismissals should be completed at the main office by 3:15. Students must be signed out. Dismissals after 3:15 will be in the parent pick-up line.**  
The adult picking up must bring a government issued Photo ID (preferably a driver's license).
  - **Parent-Pick-Up Line Reminder:** If you are picking up your child from school, please do your best to keep your vehicle to the far right when pulling out of our parking lot so that traffic does not block or slow down the emergency vehicles at the neighboring firehouse.
  - **Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports (PBIS):** We practice 3 important expectations at Caln: **RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY & SAFETY.** I ask that all adults be role models for our children/our students. This is a team effort.

We also added some pots with annual flowers.

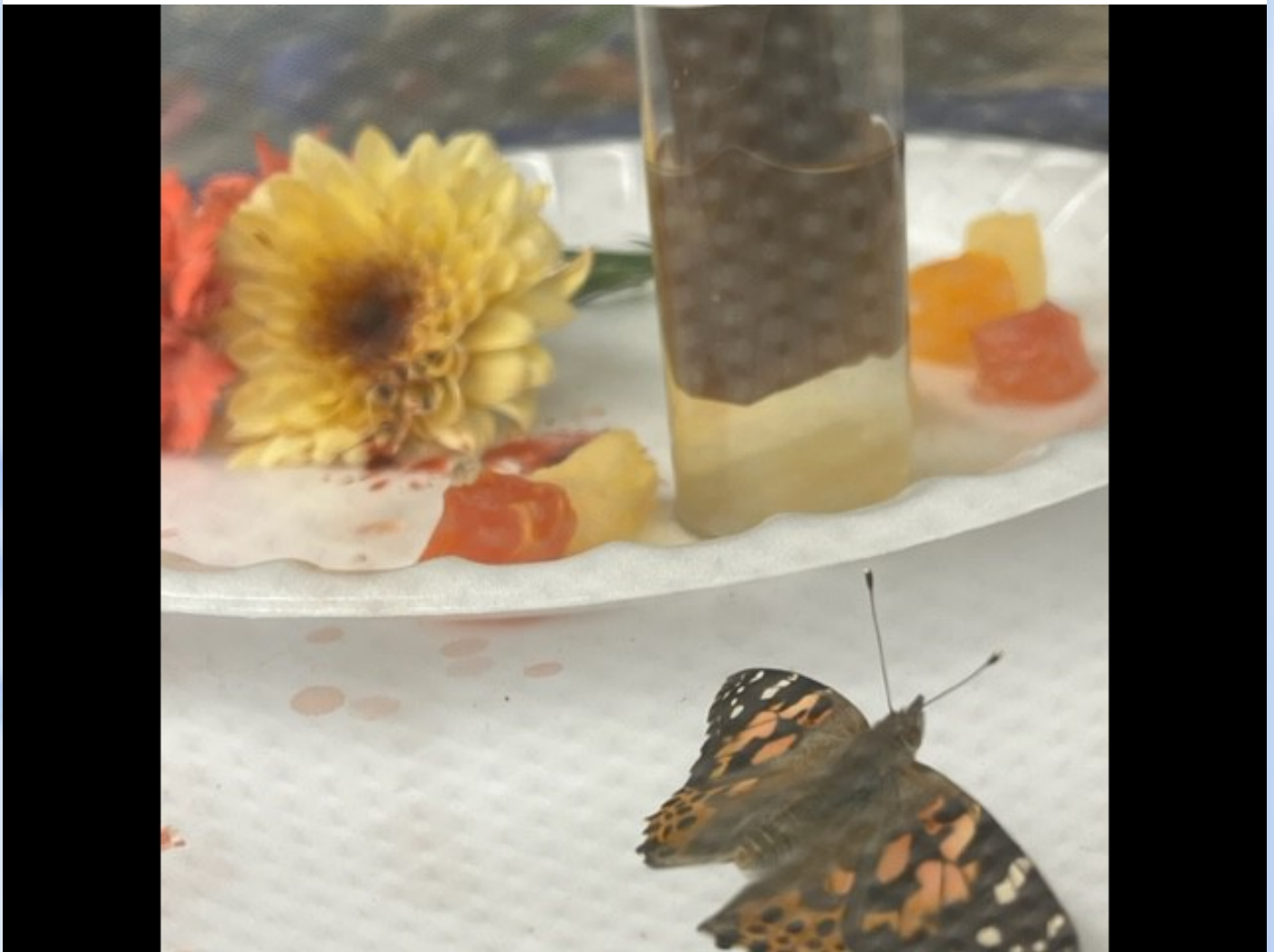
It's a small change, but I think it brings some color and warmth to the space.

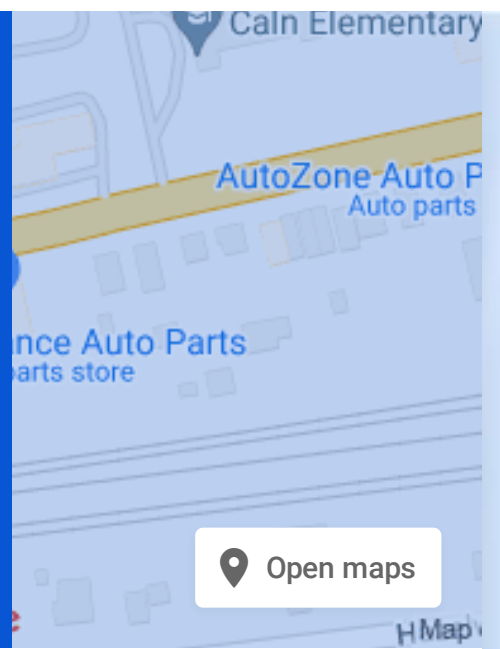
