### The End of School Year 2024 is HERE!

Dear Caln Community,

Welcome to the last week of the 2024 School Year!

This is Dr. Lennon with a few reminders for the week of 6.3.24 through 6.6.24.

The close of this school year has arrived and we are well-prepared for the final three and half days of school.

Our entire school will be celebrating our annual Field Day tomorrow. Information has already been shared and sent home in advance. However, please be sure to send your child(ren) with sun protection and a water bottle to refill.

Our superstar fifth graders will be honored at their 5th Grader Promotion Ceremony this Wednesday, 6/5/24 and we plan to begin the ceremony promptly at 10:15 AM in our auditorium/gymnasium. Please arrive **after 9:30 AM** which will give us time to welcome our K-5 students, complete our morning announcements, and complete last minute preparations. All visitors for the 5th grade promotion ceremony will arrive at the west side doors between the cafeteria and gymnasium, but doors will not open until after 9:30 AM. Please be sure to have your tickets ready and someone will escort you and your family members to your section of seats inside the gymnasium. Parking for parents and family members has been reserved at our neighboring Thorndale Church and behind the Academy Sports Complex. Please arrive in one vehicle per family and plan to park in one of these two designated areas. In addition, we will **not** be allowing balloons or celebratory items into the ceremony which could block or limit one's view.

You may bring these items into the building after the ceremony when families are invited to the homerooms. We appreciate your support and cooperation. We are looking forward to celebrating our fifth grade students, and we want to make it the best and most positive experience for them to remember.

While we are in the process of winding down the school year, there are still a few fun grade level events happening. We want to ensure that our students have lasting, positive memories of this school year. We encourage family support by speaking with your child(ren) about following our Caln expectations while practicing RESPECT (for themselves and others, and especially the adults), RESPONSIBILITY (for their own words and actions), and SAFETY (listen to adult directives and remain with an adult at all times as they are being supervised).

The grade level teams and teachers will communicate with you regarding all end of the year events.

The last day of school this year is this Thursday, June 6th, a planned half day of school, and students will be dismissed promptly at 12:30pm. There will be no staff available to supervise students after dismissal, so please plan accordingly.

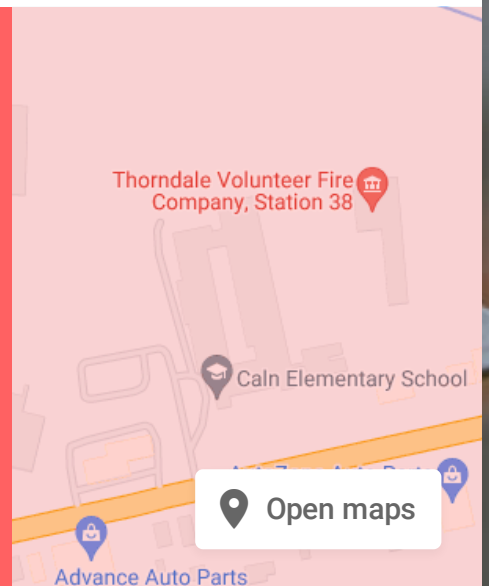
