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Middle School Math Sequence



6th Grade – CC1

7th Grade – CC2 or hybrid CC2/CC3 or Algebra

8th Grade – CC3 or Algebra Connections or Geometry

Scheduling Notes:

- 6th graders will take a CC2 and CC3 readiness assessment to determine placement for the hybrid CC2/CC3. 7th graders will take a CC3 and Algebra readiness assessment to determine if placement in Algebra for 8th grade would be warranted.
- Select 6th graders with recommendations from teachers as well as student performance in CC1 this year also took the Algebra readiness assessment to determine if placement in Algebra in 7th grade is warranted.
- For those 6th graders that are performing above grade level but not quite ready for Algebra in 7th grade, a hybrid of CC2 and CC3 will be an option.

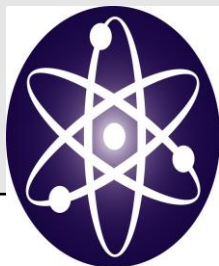

Pre-AP courses

Pre-AP courses are on-grade level academically advanced courses designed to challenge motivated students to understand a deeper level of content.

The coursework requires students to engage in independent and analytical assignments and to complete additional reading/work outside of class.

Each Middle School offers Pre-AP courses in English, Science, and Social Studies.

The only criteria for a student to enroll in Pre- AP courses in the middle school is a willingness to accept the academic challenge that the increased rigor of these courses present.

Pre-AP courses are designed to prepare students for high school Advanced Placement (AP) courses. AP courses are college-level courses taught in a high school setting.

- Physical Education




One Semester (half-year) courses




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-HAC will open to the Home Screen showing the students current schedule.

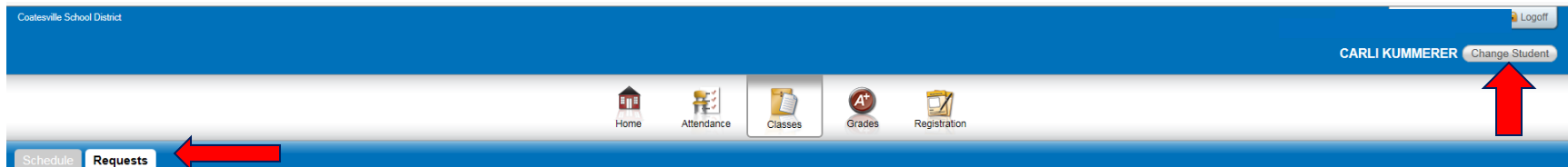
The list of Course Request by Department appears.

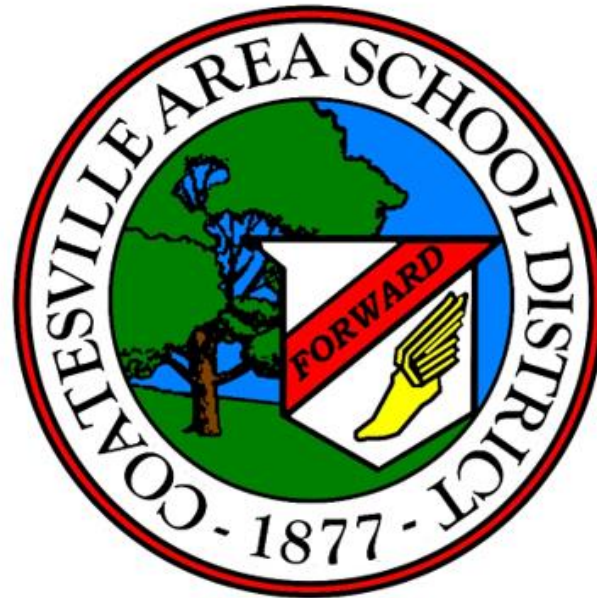
