Location: Coatesville Area Senior High School

Dates: June 17, 2024 through August 8, 2024
June 17th through July 3rd – Virtual learning only
July 8th through August 1st – Mandatory in-person learning (Monday – Thursday)
Aug 5th through Aug 8th – Virtual learning (student finalize and complete all assignments)

Costs: \$100 per course

Registration: Registration is open from May 13th - June 27th through Revtrak at the link above. Revtrak can also be accessed through the CASD website. **The Coatesville Area School District will only accept credits obtained in our summer program.**

Technology: Summer school students must have a CASD issued Chromebook

Program: CASD will offer a blended program of virtual and in-person learning through the Apex platform. The virtual portion will open on Monday, June 17th. Students will be able to work at their own pace for the weeks of June 17, June 25th and July 1st. Students who have not completed their courses during this time must attend in-person learning at the Coatesville Area Senior High School from 9:00am to 12:00pm, July 8th through August 1st. Students who still have not finished will have the week of August 5th through August 8th to finalize all assignments (virtual learning).

Attendance: Teachers will keep daily attendance from July 8th through August 1st and communicate with students and parents regarding any concerns that may arise.

Grades: A grade for the course will be given to the student following completion of the course. A numerical grade of 60% is required to receive credit for the course.
