How Our Zones of Regulation's Curriculum Relates to PBIS

We use consistent verbiage such as "What is something that puts you in your green zone?" and "What can you use in your toolbox to help you right now?" as ways for students to be a part in the conversation about their emotions.

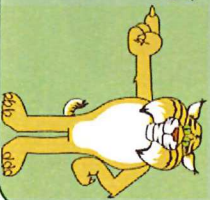
PBIS!

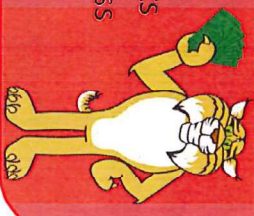
Family Engagement Opportunities!
