Chester County Economic Development Council in partnership with CEO Academy for Youth has launched the 2020 *Career Connection Academy (CCA)* Level 1 after-school program. The Coatesville Area School District was selected as our partner site to host the program.

Career Connection Academy provides healthcare workshops, field trips, life skills, and job shadow day experiences for 35 freshmen students. Students selected to participate in the Career Connect Academy meet on Wednesday from 2:30 p.m.-4:30 p.m. for program activities. This schedule may vary depending on field trips, special programs, and school closings. There is no cost to participate in the Career Connection Academy.

Highlights of our curriculum include the following:

- 1. Hands-on learning from top medical and university professionals in our region
- 2. Live surgery which includes interaction with medical professionals during the procedure
- 3. Field trip to a medical facility to learn about healthcare careers
- 4. Financial literacy workshop provided by a local bank or credit union
- 5. Industry standard healthcare certificates to assist with future employment opportunities
- 6. \$25 gift card for successfully completing registration process
- 7. \$50 gift card for completing the program with a 70% attendance rate and obtaining at least two healthcare certificates
- 8. Light snacks will be provided during workshops

Interested students should submit their application to **Christina Lee** or **Sheena Dantzler**, **Site Coordinators** no later than **November 20, 2019**. Students selected for the 2020 Career Connection Academy program are required to attend an orientation with light refreshments on November 25, 2019. During this time, students will learn about scheduled activities, receive required paperwork, and meet other students selected for the program.
