As we progress through October, we have some important upcoming dates to mark off on your calendars. Tomorrow, Tuesday October 15th, is our picture make up / retake day. Lifetouch photographers will be on site for any student who was absent during picture day or who plan to return their original photo packages for the opportunity of a retake. In order for a retake to occur, students must have the entire original package to return to the photographers. Our advisory teachers will provide students with a pass for those who were absent and send those who are requesting a retake if and only if they have their original photo packages.

We will be administering the PSAT exams at no cost to all of our 10<sup>th</sup> grade students this **Wednesday**, **October 16**. Taking the PSAT exam in 10<sup>th</sup> grade and 11<sup>th</sup> grade will assist in students scoring higher on the SAT exams later in high school. Please encourage your child to put forth their best effort in these exams so that they can be as prepared as possible for the SAT exams and also for various scholarship opportunities based on their PSAT 11<sup>th</sup> grade

Our Youth Mentoring Partnership Coaches will run a SMART goal development session which will then be submitted to advisory teachers. As you know the Coatesville Area School district has engaged in a 1:1 initiative that will provide all students in grades K-12 with a Chromebook and an internet hotspot. Distribution is scheduled for November 6, 2019.

You should have already received the Technology 1:1 Handbook as well as the information on the Technology Insurance Fee (to read over this information again, please go to the district website: <a href="https://www.casdschools.org/Page/6548">https://www.casdschools.org/Page/6548</a>).

Your signed 1:1 agreement (found at the end of the handbook) and your TIF payment are due by October 30th.

Additionally, to reduce any more confusion and ensure that TIF's are safely collected and funneled through the proper channels, the CASD technology department will be stationed at each school to collect TIF's from students.
