- Students must not have any disciplinary incident that resulted in an In-School Suspension or Out of School Suspension from the time period from Monday, September 23 – Friday, October 5 (tickets will be revoked if a suspension has occurred after the purchase of a ticket).

As a friendly reminder, if you have to come to school for a meeting or pick up your child on an early dismissal, I ask that you please be sure to have your appropriate identification so that our attendance office secretaries can check you in through our Raptor System. Please park in the designated visitors lot located at the bottom of our stairs/ramp area from the main entrance on the second floor. If you are remaining in the building for a period of time during your visit, your identification will be maintained at that location until your departure where you can return the issued visitors pass and your ID will be returned to you. Additionally, after you sign in to our system, our attendance office will have whoever you may be visiting, come to escort you to the appropriate meeting location. These visitors procedures are for security purposes and we appreciate your cooperation and understanding.

It is never too early to start discussing and exploring post-secondary opportunities with your child. Some of these opportunities may include a college or university. Our guidance department has begun to establish college visit opportunities for all 10th grade students. If your child is a 10th grade student, he or she should have received a college visit request survey that helps guide our counselors in attempting to have your child's visit be within their top five choices. It is important that students have the appropriate field trip paperwork and signatures returned for their assigned trip. Without the fieldtrip permission forms and signatures, your child will not be able to attend. To date, the following colleges and universities have been confirmed and our guidance department is working on arranging for additional ones either this fall or spring. 
