
We suggest doing 2 things before April 14th

- Students should
 - Log in to their School District email
 - Log in to BSD


1. Log Into Their Email

- All students now have a CASD Schools Email.
- Their email is their StudentID@casdschools.org
 - For Example <u>1234567@casdschools.org</u>
- The next slide will show you how to access their email. I suggest setting the website up as a bookmark on their Chrome Bookmark bar.


A few email tips to share with your child

- Do not give out your passwords to anyone
- Send only emails you want your parents/guardians to see
- All emails from teachers will come from their CASD accounts
- Include your name at the bottom of the email

2. Log into BSD

- BSD is a platform we are using for students to be able to see all their classes in one place.
 - From there teachers can have students use other websites to get material
- Your child should log into BSD every day and click into every classroom to see if there are new assignments.
- Teachers will use BSD log in information for attendance

How do I add them to the bookmark bar?

We suggest adding both the email and BSD to your child's bookmark bar so when they open chrome they can easily click on both websites.
